Recommendation # 1 (located on page 9)

Continue to revise and implement the nursing systematic evaluation plan to identify, asses, evaluate, set benchmarks, and provide an action plan for all aspects of the nursing program (i.e. admission, attrition, graduation) and continue to include all stakeholders in the decision-making process (i.e. Advisory Committee, Faculty).

Recommendation # 2 (located on page 15)

Continue to explore and evaluate all resources which impact on the quality of nursing education provided to students, i.e., new technology, simulation laboratory, and skills laboratory for current and future enrollment.

Recommendation # 3 (located on page 34)

Encourage faculty to apply to the NCSBN as item writers for the exam.

Recommendation # 4 (located on page 52)

Continue to make revisions to internal processes such as:

- a. Facility Agreements
 - i. Continue to review the status of facility agreements per lowa Administrative Code Chapter 2.
 - ii. Include the printed name above the signature in all forms.

Recommendation # 5 (located on pages 59-60)

Continue to use methods to improve NCLEX-RN test results and examine all variables impacting student's success rates.
