What is it?

The International Friendship Program is created for both American families, and international students studying at IHCC. Students and volunteers are matched up based on interests, values, and other aspects.

Remember, there is no "typical American family." We are open to placements with a single person or a large family, with couples as well as with non-traditional families.
