

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TO SAVE YOU TIME AND MONEY!

○ Report all other aid/assistance to your Office of Financial Aid

Tell the Financial Aid office whenever you receive any other aid from off-campus sources, like scholarships from your high school, civic group grants, military aid, etc.

○ Report all changes to your FAFSA Information

Tell your friendly Financial Aid folks if any of the information you reported on your FAFSA has changed. For example, changes in your: family's financial circumstances, number of credit hours you're taking, academic program, housing plans (off-campus, with parents or residence hall), NAME or mailing ADDRESS, etc.

○ Remember! You have to reapply for financial aid each year

All Financial Aid is awarded on an annual basis based on the academic year. This means if you start at IHCC Summer term, you file a FAFSA for Summer and a new one for the following year starting with the Fall term.

○ Three-Term & Four-Term Aid

Aid is usually awarded for three or four terms for the academic year, based on your program and expected graduation date. Minimum enrollment for loans: at least 4 credit hours each term (1/2-time).

Please be sure to update your address with IHCC if you move. All correspondence will be sent to the current address on file. It is required that you provide a photo ID before an advisor can assist you.
