





Indian Hills Community College 2017-18 to 2019-20 Entry Cohorts
Transfer Students by CC Credit Hours --> Regents --> Returned for 3rd Year or Graduated








Academic Area by Regents 2017-18 to 2021-22 Entry Cohorts

Student Category --> Returned for 3rd Year or Graduated


