



<u>Cohorts</u> identify when an lowa CC transfer student first enrolled at a Regent university (e.g., 2009-10 Cohort = entered a Regent university during Summer or Fall of 2009 or Spring of 2010). <u>Student counts</u> (numbers in small font within cells) represent the count of unique transfer students who enrolled in a Regent university for a specific cohort or aggregation of cohorts.

Graduation rates are calculated by dividing the number of lowa CC transfers who earned a first Bachelor's degree at a Regent university within 3 years of entry by the number of lowa CC transfers who entered a Regent university for that cohort.

Academic Area uses the first two digits of the CIP code from a student's current first major to place them into a general academic area of study.
