# Commercial Driver Training (Class A)

Tuition: \$4,800 (Tuition and fees are subject to change) Weekday Courses: Mon - Thurs | 8am-4pm

By completing the Indian Hills Commercial Driving Program, in just six short weeks **you could be making \$60,000 or more!** One of every 19 people in America is employed by the trucking industry, so what are YOU waiting for?

This course meets FMCSA ELDT standards and requirements. You will learn proper driving techniques (Defensive Driving), proper backing procedures for combination vehicles, map reading, trip planning and scheduling and proper communication skills. Indian Hills is an authorized Iowa DOT 3rd Party testing provider; upon completion, students will take their DOT skills and driving tests to obtain their Class A CDL. You will be trained with a 10 and 13 speed manual transmission vehicle.

- Drug Screen (included in tuition)
- Bronze Score on the NCRC Assessment

This course will discuss and review the Federal knowledge requirements for trainees seeking a Hazardous Materials (H) endorsement to operate CMVs used in the transportation of hazardous materials as defined in § 383.5. Trainees seeking an H endorsement, as described in § 383.93(c)(4), must complete this curriculum with an 80% or higher in order to take the State administered knowledge test for the H endorsement.
