- Three years' experience required consisting of a combination of the following: manufacturing production welding, structural welding, pipe and plate welding on carbon steel, stainless steel, and aluminum.
- Must have knowledge of welding and blueprint symbols. Familiarity with AWS D1.1 and D14.1 codebooks desired.
- College level teaching experience preferred.
- Must interact positively with students and colleagues creating an environment conducive to student learning.
