

Adjunct Instructor, Aviation Pilot

- Satisfactory completion of initial and recurrent ground/flight proficiency checks

This is a part-time adjunct position with a flexible schedule, and opportunities for weekends, days, or evenings. Pay is \$22 per hour. A living stipend is also provided for those that guarantee a minimum of 15 hours of work per week.
