About the EAA: Established in 1953, the Experimental Aircraft Association is an international and diverse organization of members with a wide range of aviation interests and backgrounds. The EAA mission is to grow participation in aviation by promoting the “Spirit of Aviation.”

- 1) There are two scholarships available, each for \$1000. The scholarships will be awarded to applicants that meet the scholarship guidelines and demonstrate their commitment to a career in an aviation related program.
- 2) A scholarship may be awarded to any individual who will attend a college, junior college, university, vocational, trade or technical school, or other training program as deemed appropriate by EAA Chapter 135 in calendar years 2026/2027 and who is currently a resident of Iowa.
- 3) A scholarship may be awarded to a student who exhibits and can demonstrate their sincere desire to continue their education and career in a field of study related to aviation. Some examples of fields of study are the following: Aviation Maintenance, Aviation Electronics Technician, Avionics Technician, Aviation Pilot Training, Aeronautical/Aerospace Engineering, Aviation & Airport Management.
- 4) The applicant's information provided in this application must enable EAA Chapter 135 to obtain a clear picture of desire and interest in that their pursuit of a degree in a field of aviation will lead to a career utilizing that knowledge.
- 5) The amount of scholarship, if awarded, will be \$1000.
- 6) If awarded, the scholarship will be paid directly to the institution or program of the applicant's choice at the successful conclusion of either the first quarter or semester.

- 7) The successful applicant will be requested to attend one EAA Chapter 135 meeting and provide an overview of the aviation related aspects of their training to the chapter members.
- 8) Please fill out all the requested information. Specific details documented in your essay will allow a full understanding of your individual circumstances, which will be helpful.
- 9) All applications will become the property of EAA chapter 135 and will not be returned.
- 10) Personal interviews may be arranged as required.
- 11) The deadline for receipt of this application is on or before March 15, 2026. All applicants will be notified if their request for funding has or has not been approved by May 15th, 2026.
- 12) All applicants – successful or not, will be provided a one-year free membership to EAA Chapter 135 and will receive all chapter communications and be invited to all chapter activities.
