## If you're unable to provide your 2021 Form W-2

The quickest way to obtain a copy of your current year Form W-2 is through your employer. If you can't get your Form W-2 from your employer, you can get a wage and income transcript online by using the Get Transcript Online service at <a href="https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript">https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript</a>. You can also use <a href="Form 4506-T">Form 4506-T</a>, Request for Transcript of Tax Return</a>. Check the box for Form W-2, specify which tax year(s) you need. Mail or fax Form 4506-T to the address based on the *Where to File Addresses* chart. Allow 10 business days from the IRS received date to receive the transcript.

<sup>\*</sup> If you were born before January 2, 1957, you're considered to be 65 or older at the end of 2021. (If your spouse died in 2021, see <u>Death of spouse</u>, later. If you're preparing a return for someone who died in 2021, see <u>Death of taxpayer</u>, later.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Gross income means all income you receive in the form of money, goods, property, and services that isn't exempt from tax, including any income from sources outside the United States or from the sale of your main home (even if you can exclude part or all of it). Don't include any social security benefits unless (a) you're married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2021, or (b) one-half of your social security benefits plus your other gross income and any tax-exempt interest is more than \$25,000 (\$32,000 if married filing jointly). If (a) or (b) applies, see the Form 1040 and 1040-SR instructions to figure the taxable part of social security benefits you must include in gross income. Gross income includes gains, but not losses, reported on Form 8949 or Schedule D. Gross income from a business means, for example, the amount on Schedule C, line 7; or Schedule F, line 9. But in figuring gross income, don't reduce your income by any losses, including any loss on Schedule C, line 7; or Schedule F, line 9.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> If you didn't live with your spouse at the end of 2021 (or on the date your spouse died) and your gross income was at least \$5, you must file a return regardless of your age.
